



Camp Young Judaea Midwest Parent Fact Sheet For the 2010 Season

Camp Fee

The camp fee includes tuition, snacks, laundry, yearbook, camp t-shirt, Bunk1 email program and all out of camp trips. Transportation costs are additional.

Session 1 for entering 3rd-9th graders
(June 20-July 12) \$3,400

Session 2 for entering 3rd-9th graders
(July 15-August 5) \$3,200

Mini Session 2 for entering 3rd-5th graders
(July 15-July 25) \$1,900

Transportation

Transportation costs are not included with the tuition.

Deposit

All camper enrollment application forms must be accompanied by a \$500 deposit per child. The deposit includes a \$100 non-refundable administrative fee.

Camper applications

Camp applications require a parent signature. All forms must be sent via mail to 4711 Golf Rd, Ste 600, Skokie, IL 60076. The \$500 deposit per child must accompany the camper application in order to be accepted. No facsimile copies will be accepted.

Acknowledgements

All camper applications will be acknowledged in writing indicating the status of the application.

Balance Due

The family's balance must be paid in full by May 1, 2010.

Cancellations

CYJ Midwest must be notified of all cancellations in writing. The deposit, less the \$100 administrative fee, is refundable only through May 1, 2010. No refunds are made after May 1, 2010. Scholarship funds are subject to refund penalties.

Referral Fee

If a current camp family refers a new camper, they will receive \$250 off their tuition rate. The new family MUST contact the camp in writing with the name of the referral family. The new camper must enroll in order to receive the discount.

Sibling Discount

A sibling discount of \$100 may be taken for each additional camper in the same family after the first child. This discount may not be deducted from the deposit; it is credited on the first statement. Mini Session campers are eligible for the sibling discount.

Scholarship

Anyone applying for local scholarships should still send camp a completed application and a \$500 deposit. Space at camp is only reserved upon receipt of a signed enrollment form and deposit.

First time Camper Grants

A limited number of grants for first time campers are available through Young Judaea and the Foundation for Jewish Camp.
