



A Full Summer at CYJ? Absolutely!

Many families and campers have asked us about the possibility of a full summer program at CYJ. We are proud to bring you GESHER – the “bridge” between first and second session at CYJ!

What are the Dates?

GESHER will start on June 20th and end on August 5th (these are the starting and ending dates of 1st and 2nd session).

What is the cost?

The cost for an additional session has been significantly reduced from full tuition:

Registered for first and want to stay for Second Session: \$2200

Registered for 2nd and want to come for First Session: \$2400

Not yet registered: \$5600

What happens between sessions?

During the intersession period (7/12-7/15), campers will participate in a special trip exclusive to GESHER campers. While the nature of the trip will be determined based on the number of participants, we will be taking advantage of the fantastic natural beauty of Wisconsin.

What’s the difference between the GESHER program and just coming to camp for two sessions?

Campers who stay on for 2nd session will get to experience a great intersession trip. But in order to run special programming for campers who choose to stay for a full summer experience, we must have **AT LEAST TEN campers per age group**. Second session age groups are as follows:

Ofarim: 3rd-5th

Arazim: 6th-7th

Bogrim: 8th-9th

(Grades as of Fall 2010)

Regardless of the number of campers who stay, a full summer at camp will include new friends, new programs, and a whole lot of fun!

If we do not have this critical number, we will do our best to ensure that campers staying for a full summer have an advantage during choice periods and get the opportunity to experience the parts of CYJ they enjoy the most. I expect that many of the campers who choose this option will be our older campers. We will look to these campers to be “*dugmaot ishiot*” (personal examples) of leadership for the rest of camp.
